THE BERLIN ALBUM is now schedule for release at the beginning of April entitled BERLIN A CONCERT FOR THE PEOPLE.

As you know BJH are currently working their way round Germany and those of you who took up our offer of the Frankfurt trip will, as I am writing this, be on your way home. I'd like to hear from you about it for possible inclusion in the next newsletter please. Incidentally, by the end of this German tour the band will have sold more than 400,000 tickets and this makes it the most successful rock tour that any band has ever undertaken in Germany.
