

OVER TO MEL

Below are Mel's answers to the questions you have sent in.

1. Why did you change over from a Ludwig kit to a Pearl one ?

Having spoken to different drummers and musicians, and keeping one eye on developments, it became apparent that Pearl had the quality of Ludwig and also better design ideas. Especially in a live situation "the bar" design of Pearl meant less mike stands and leads etc. Altogether neater and cleaner approach to design from Pearl.

- Can you play any other instrument apart from drums and cymbals ?
 - I like to play guitar.
- 3. How much work such as re-dubbing and re-recording was done to the Concert for the People album and what is your opinion of live albums and also those that have been extensively re-recorded?

A good question. Re-dubbing and re-recording are usually only done when the quality, ie too much cymbal covering tom-tom sound etc, is suspect. Generally there is never enough time on a live gig to cover all problems so some amount of re-recording has to take place. Should a Formula One driver have to use pit stops! Same kind of thing.

- 4. When and why did you decide to grow a beard?
 - I can't grow a beard.
- 5. Don't you mind not being a "front" musician of Barclay James Harvest like John and Les ?
 - Not at all, and I never think about it until asked such as now.
- 6. What's your favourite place for a holiday ?
 - The Algarve, Portugal.

7. What do you like to do in your spare time at home ?

Read, listen to music.

8. What do you think of FGTH, Marillion and Wham! ?

First, FGTH, production is extraordinary. First and last, FGTH is production.

Marillion - I've only heard the single which I particularly liked.

Wham! - Does nothing at all.

9. Have you got a collection of Barclay stuff, ie reports, posters, interviews, records, tapes, etc?

A very few things. No scrapbooks or anything like that. But having said that I don't take photo's or anything.

10. What are your plans for your future ?

To stop doing question 11!

11. Do you get nervous when you're not on stage ?

Nervous about what? I sometimes get anxious about the most ridiculous things.

12. What incident or person has most influenced your life and why ?

I don't think anything or anyone has influenced me. I kind of absorb everything. I have no strict rules about things.

13. What other drummers do you particularly admire?

Steve Gadd, Geoff Pocaro.

14 What do you think would be your occupation if you weren't a member of BJH ?

Well, I'd almost certainly be a musician.

15. Do you like children ?

Very much, they are our future.

16. What's the most embarrassing thing that's ever happened to you on stage ?

The most embarrassing is not repeatable! I have fallen off my stool quite a few times though!.

17. What were your feelings about Wembley?

Incredible. Remember, we'd just done an English tour (sorry British tour), gone back into Europe, and then to come back and finish at Wembley. A dream.

18. For how many years do you hope to continue with BJH ?

Well, when we first started we didn't set a time limit. The same philosophy still applies.

19. What is your favourite BJH album and song ?

All of them, really.

20. Who is your favourite modern day songwriter ?

Paul Simon.

- 21. Would you like to record with any other artist and, if so, who ?

 Anyone and everyone.
- 22. Do you still go to concerts as a punter, if so, who do you see. If not, is it possible to say why and who have you seen in the past?

Yes of course. Living here in Munich and still having some things to do back home in England, I miss a lot of people I would like to see. Who have I seen? Frank Zappa, Paul Young, Yes, Foreigner, FGTH, Big Country (just this year)
