

Open Letter from BJH's Management to all Fan Club Members

For the last 3/4 years now a gentleman by the name of Robert Godfrey has been claiming, through his own ENID newsletter, that he was responsible for the writing, if not entirely, in part, of many of the BJH early compositions.

Because of the ridiculous nature of his claims and the fact that until now they have been made in the private circulation of his own magazine it has been our deliberate intention to ignore them. However, on March 1st or thereabouts each member of the band was issued with a writ on behalf of Mr Godfrey claiming part ownership in the compositions written during the early days of their career.

John, Les, Mel and Woolly vigorously refute such claims and are, at present, compiling substantial evidentary fact to prove that although for a period of time Mr Godfrey did work as a <u>musical arranger</u> during the period in question, in no way was he responsible for the composition of the original copyright works. It is the opinion of the band and the management that as long standing members of FOBJH you should be kept fully informed as to the facts of the case as and when they become available and to that end both Lindsay and myself will be making it our personal responsibility to communicate with you on this subject.
